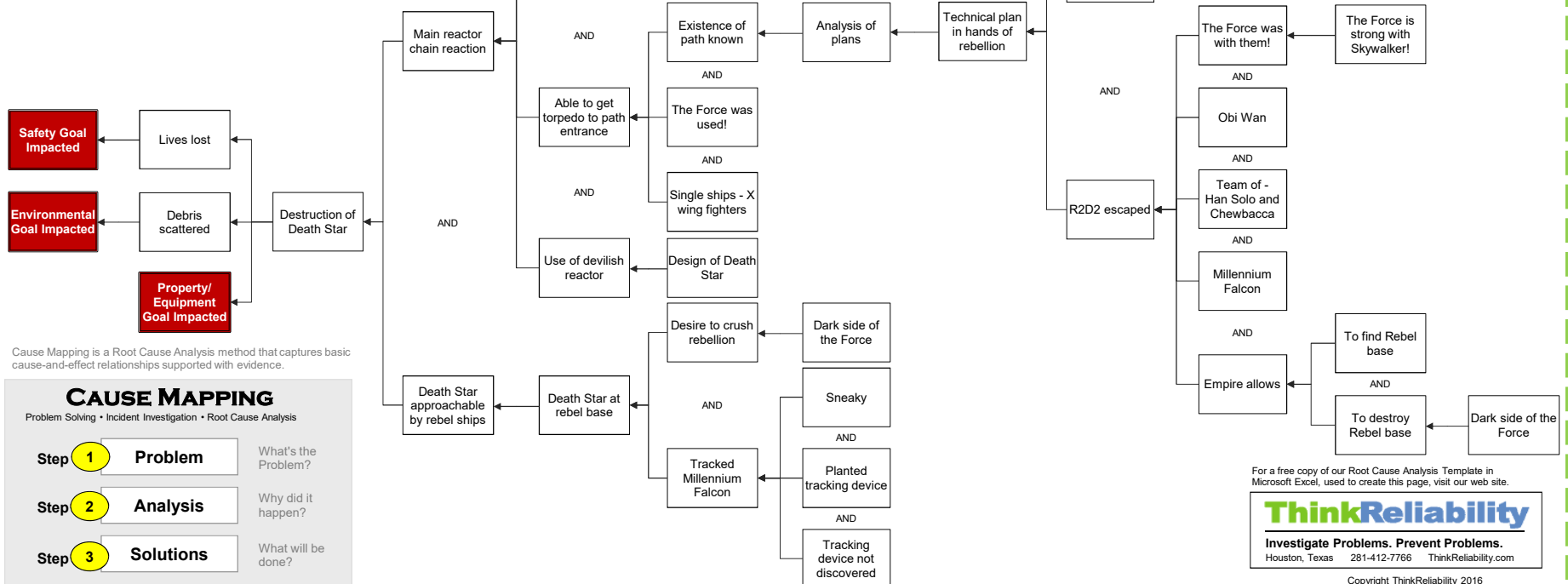
<b>What</b>	Problem(s)	Death Star destruction, Empire weapon not available

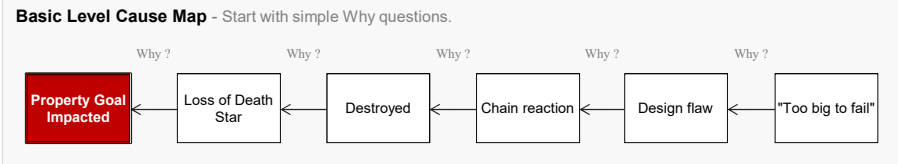
